SUBJECT: Cancellation of MPR 1280.4-DEV001, "Deviation to MSFC Correction Action System"

In accordance with MPR 1410.2, Sections 3.1.4 and 3.3.3, QD01 requests cancellation of MPR 1280.4-DEV001, "Deviation to MSFC Correction Action System."

The requirements for MPR 1280.4-DEV001 specify not using the MSFC Corrective Action System to process in-house Constellation Program (CxP) Discrepancy Reports but to instead use equivalent processes required by CxP 70068, "Constellation Problem Reporting, Analysis, and Corrective Action (CxPRACA) Requirements" and CxP 72353, "Ares Projects Processing of MSFC In-House Constellation Problems." Those documents are not applicable to the Space Launch System (SLS) Program.

Therefore, the current deviation is no longer valid and MPR 1280.4-DEV001 is no longer required. If a comparable deviation is needed for SLS processes, it will be submitted at a later date.
