SUBJECT: Cancellation of MPR 8040.2, "Product Identification and Traceability"

In accordance with MPR 1410.2, 2.1.5, "Marshall Directives System," ED01 requests approval for cancellation of MPR 8040.2, "Product Identification and Traceability."

Requirements for MSFC configuration identification and have been incorporated into MPR 7123.1, "MSFC Systems Engineering Processes and Requirements," Revision B.

The requirement for unique serial number assignment has been incorporated into MPR 1280.2, "Process Control," Revision G-2. Requirements for product traceability by Safety and Mission Assurance (S&MA) and manufacturing organizations that are equivalent to requirements in MPR 8040.2 are addressed in MPR 1280.2, "Process Control."

Requirements and guidance related to product data released through the MSFC Release Desk for identification, serial and lot numbering, and material traceability have been incorporated into MSFC-STD-555, "MSFC Engineering Documentation Standard," Revision J.

Therefore, MPR 8040.2 is no longer required.
